e-Board Features




Arrow: click on arrow to change direction

Pencil: writing tool. Click on Pencil to change it to a highlighter.

Line: click & hold where you want line to begin, drag to where you want line to end, and release mouse button.

Ellipse: click your mouse and drag until size you want, and release. You can adjust line thickness and color.

T for Text: type by pressing T and then click where you want to begin. Select text color first.

 Undo last change.

Line Thickness

Color Palette: for drawing and text tools

Erases all drawings on e-Board

Clear slide removes EVERYTHING from e-Board

Import image or graphic (JPEG or GIF format)

Save what is displayed as a slide in the Content Folder.

Screen Grab allows you to post a screen shot of your desktop

Enable allows you to give control to a participant
